Facebook username scramble

Facebook's new customised usernames have resulted in a rush to steal celebrity profiles and even sparked a spat between two American men after one registered the other's name.

Facebook said more than 200,000 usernames were snapped up in the first three minutes and about one million in the first hour on Saturday.

But not everyone is happy with the new profiles in which www.facebook.com/username replaces a string of text and numbers.

Florida man Mike Pence registered www.facebook.com/obiefernandez as his URL.

Within minutes his friend, the real Obie Fernandez, lashed out, asking, "Are you f...ing serious?"

Another American, Christine Shipley, snagged [/default.aspx](http://default.aspx), which could be confused with the home page for Facebook.

The San Francisco woman had received 340 friend requests by the end of the day.

"Traffic spiked when the first-come, first-serve period for Facebook usernames opened," a spokesman said.

But several high-profile figures missed out on securing their names.

Prime Minister Kevin Rudd is still to secure [/kevinrudd](http://kevinrudd), despite the fact he was forced to tweet under the username @kevinruddPM when someone took @kevinrudd.

Federal Opposition leader Malcolm Turnbull missed out on [/malcolmturnbull](http://malcolmturnbull).

But no-one has yet registered [/johnbrumby](http://johnbrumby).
